Camp Manager Opening



The following shall be the duties of the Camp Manager of Camp Stover.

1. Camp Time(s) of duties shall begin when the water is turned on (approx. May 15th) through and until the water is turned off (approx. Sept. 30).
2. Make arrangements with the Camp Stover Board Chairman if time off is needed during open Camp time.
3. The Camp Manager shall be on duty & in Camp during Camp Week & any time that the Camp facilities are rented out. Duties: include but are not limited to:
 - Check grounds on a daily basis to determine who is in camp and maintain a log of use.
 - Have rules and regulations available for all campers and posted in district buildings.
 - Encourage camp users to register ASAP and complete the form.
 - Determine if there is any misuse, violations or misunderstanding of Camp Stover rules and regulations.
 - Collect fees as set by the Camp Stover Board.
 - Evaluate and enforce fire safety regulations as set by Camp Stover and the Forest Service.
 - Keep restrooms and shower buildings clean, supplied, and garbage emptied.
 - Perform light maintenance work as needed, such as water system, electrical, touch up painting, noxious weeds and brush.
 - Assist all groups who are renting Camp Stover and ensure facilities are ready for arrival as well as in good shape when renters are ready to leave.
 - Assess for damage for report to Ex. Board to ensure facilities are kept in good shape and ready for use.
