“Adopt A Project” will help to pool our resources and get more people involved in Camp projects.

Supporters of Camp can donate some or all of the cost of a project or some or all of the labor for the project or projects of their choice.

SMALL PROJECTS (that need either money &/ or labor)

- Jr. High Girls need step on road side of cabin
- The new tool shed behind the Sanctuary needs a roof that will survive the winter snow
- Label power meters and breakers with permanent tags
- Sand and paint Church benches being used outside
- Sand and seal roadside benches
- Replace 3 cracked windows in the dining hall
- Replace cracked window at Jr. High boys

FUNDING FOR WORK CAMP PROJECTS

- Gravel for J.H. door at dining hall
- Gravel for road from Jack’s to Jr. High
- Paint for knep cabin, Jr. boys cabin, inside Jr. girls cabin, etc. (12 gal)
- Replace the back steps of the Amsey
- Build a permanent shelter for the water valves at the Amsey that can be accessed during the winter
- Widen the foot bridge to allow for golf cart access for emergencies
- Several other miscellaneous projects

These are just some of what needs to be done at camp.

The first list (small projects) will be left with our caretakers, Eddy & Becky Motley. This list will be updated as we go through the summer months. Please check with them as you take on a project and again when you finish.
